RE: New Industrial Stormwater Permit – Effective July 1, 2015

This letter is to notify the legally responsible party for the above referenced business that the State has a new Industrial Permit which becomes effective in seven months – July 1, 2015. Based on our records, your business is most likely required to comply with the new Industrial Stormwater General Permit (IGP).

Please note that there are many new business types which are now required to obtain permit coverage under the IGP; visit the state's webpage to determine whether your business is now required to obtain an IGP, and to review the regulatory changes that will affect your business operations: [http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/water\\_issues/programs/stormwater/industrial.shtml](http://www.swrcb.ca.gov/water_issues/programs/stormwater/industrial.shtml)

**There are significant changes to the IGP that will require revisions to your facility's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) which includes increased requirements for best management practice implementation, inspection, and monitoring requirements.** Of note, your facility will be required to have a Qualified Industrial Stormwater Practitioner prepare documents and implement the compliance program, and depending on your facility operations, you may be required to implement structural controls and treatment systems.

Today, the State notified the local municipalities that **FREE Workshops** have been scheduled throughout the state which will be held to assist businesses with this transition. Reservations are required to attend these free workshops, and tickets are disappearing quickly. Please see the enclosed flyer for dates and registration information.
